1. San José City Tour

Enjoy Costa Rica's Culture and history at it's best! Journey through San Jose's most important landmarks. Take the opportunity to visit the national theatre as well as the best museum this beautiful city has to offer. At the end of the trip get a chance to find authentic Costa Rican souvenirs at the best price.

2. Coffee Tour Cafe Britt

We invite you to join us for a true Coffee Experience. Stroll through our organic coffee fields, lush tropical gardens, and plantation roasters. And let us lead you on an entertaining multimedia tour depicting the journey of coffee, from plantation to cup.

3. Arenal Volcano

Our most popular tour. The Arenal Volcano is one of the most active volcanoes in the Americas. You will have the opportunity to feel the ground tremble and see the explosions of ash and lava in the night sky- a natural display of fireworks. Next, we will visit the hot springs of the volcano, where you can relax in the soothing waters and be caressed by the cool night air while observing the stars and the rest of this spectacular scenario.



4. Monteverde Biological Cloud Forest Reserve

Take one of Costa Rica's most diverse natural history walks! Positioned atop the Continental Divide in western Costa Rica, the Preserve extends down both the Caribbean and Pacific slopes. The resulting combination of climatic and geographic factors creates temperature and humidity gradients that change dramatically over relatively short distances. This Cloud Forest homes unique animal species such as the red and blue Poison Arrow frogs as well as the Golden Toad, practically impossible to see at present. Splendid quetzals and Bellbirds fly about the canopy of the forest trees, and iridescent hummingbirds hover around in search of nectar. Because of the activity patterns of animals in this forest, we recommend taking this tour early in the morning so that you can live the experience of seeing wild animals in their natural habitat.



5. Poas Volcano

The tour will take you along the Pan-American heading towards the town of Alajuela. During the ascent to the volcano we stop at the coffee fields for an explanation, then we will pass through fern farm, strawberry plantations and flowers farms. On the top of the volcano, we will spend enough time to observe the principal crater with its sulfur fumaroles. Thereafter, we will walk to the beautiful Botos lagoon where you can see the diverse flora and fauna of the cloud forest.



6. Irazu Volcano

In route to Southern area by taking Pan-American Highway we will start the ascent of the colossus "Irazú". The winding road traverses the fertile earth that is cultivated with many kinds of vegetables while an extensive panorama is being observed. At the top, of the volcano the principal craters are seen and on a clear day it might be possible to distinguish both the Atlantic and Pacific Oceans. We will continue descending to the city of Cartago, stop at the Basilica of Los Angeles, and a traditional pilgrimage center for many Catholics.



7. Canopy Tour

The Canopy tour is a once in a lifetime experience consisting of sliding on a cable between platforms flying through the treetops. The length of the cable is 8200 feet between 19 platforms. The Montezuma Canopy has one of the longest cables in the country.

8. Rafting in the Tenorio River

The Tenorio River offers an adventure level, suitable for beginners but able of satisfying experienced rafters in its 10 miles of pure adrenaline. This river offers a great natural richness, where many animal species, such as monkeys, gorgeous birds, iguanas and river turtle, among other, all these beautiful floras can be seen from the raft. During our journey, we will stop for a picnic with fresh fruits, cookies and drinks.



9. Whales and Dolphins at Ballena Marine National Park

For all the people desirous to enjoy outdoor activities outdoors, in contact with nature, interested in learning about whales, dolphins and other cetaceans of Costa Rica. It's a unique places where you will be able to see colossal Humpback Whales (*Megaptera novaeangliae*) and different dolphin species. This area was declared as protected in order to assure the reproduction and nesting of many turtle species, and also for preserving the productivity of the biological communities of this zone (like sand beaches, rocky beaches, cliffs, islands, reefs, etc.). It has a great value for the environmental education and the tourism.



10. Olive Ridley's Nesting in Ostional

We will depart at night to the National Wildlife Refuge Ostional, where, together with a local guide, we will walk the beach in search for the Olive Ridley turtles. Its importance is based in the protection that the Wildlife Refuge gives to the fauna of the area that includes olive ridley and leatherback turtles, and a wide variety of marine birds. You will learn their reproduction strategies, natural history, their situation in Costa Rica and the world, as well as learning about the rational use of their eggs and other conservation strategies.



11. Explore the Islands of the Gulf of Nicoya

Rediscover exotic destinies of the Gulf of Nicoya; virgin islands, paradisiacal unexplored beaches and other natural beauties present in the Pacific of Costa Rica. We will visit: Guayabo, Negritos, Pájaros, Tortuga and many others. We will enjoy a delicious lunch in the beach of your choice, and we will continue with our exploration of the Gulf, where we could do some snorkeling, in any island. By the end of the day we will have the return to the hotel around 4:00 pm.

12. Curu National Park

A guided visit through a beautiful biological reserve, where you'll see just about every animal species this region has to offer. This stroll includes soft drinks, a telescope and, depending on the season, the rare treat of wild fruits.

13. Montezuma Village & Waterfall

Visit the bohemian village of Montezuma, where you'll see the fine craftsmanship of its artisans in every corner of its picturesque streets. After exploring the village, take a refreshing dip in the beautiful Montezuma Waterfall.

14. ATV Adventure

Dash through white sand virgin beaches; skid through muddy jungle trails and splash across rivers. A day of adventure and pure adrenaline! Make a stop halfway to cool off with a dip in a pristine waterfall.

15. Cabo Blanco National Park

Enjoy a bus ride through the towns of Tambor, Cobano and Cabuya, on your way to the Cabo Blanco National Park. Marvel at the great variety of flora and fauna.

16. Mal País Surf

We will take you to the most beautiful beaches of Nicoya Peninsula, where you can ride the waves, one of the best places for surf in Costa Rica. If you are a beginner or Intermediate, we can offer you lessons in a Pacifica Surf School (additional charge of \$35 per person).
